## Expert Thoughts Auston Matricardi; Crimson Quarry

"Barr became a three true outcomes type of player in his first season as a starter. He tied for first in the Big Ten in home runs with 17, but he also struck out 84 times. He also drew 36 walks and drove in 51 runs in the middle of the Hoosier lineup.

His main tool is his tantalizing power, but there should be concerns about his strikeout numbers. He also developed as a fielder over the course of the 2019 season, eventually becoming a plus glove at the hot corner."

## IU Head Coach Jeff Mercer

"We always thought with his strength and the twitchiness he has that he had a chance to hit for power, He hit for some power in the fall, but you start talking about 10-plus home runs and it's a game changer."
"He has a really high degree of rotational force and explosive force (in his swing) that allows him to really generate a lot of power in a small area. That burst allows that power to play pole-to-pole. The hard part for him is he creates so much rotational force that it pulls the barrelhead down. You have to control the barrelhead. We've talked to him a lot about controlling the top hand. As we've gotten him bigger and stronger and made some adjustments to allow that twitch and force and power top lay up, it's also
pulled the bat head down. He has to make the adjustment back to keep the bat head up and make it a more playable power."

"This athletic RHH MIF shows a tremendous future on the diamond with the makings of a special type player at the next level. A leadoff type hands are quick ( 89 mph exit velocity) as he squares the ball up consistently driving it on a line. A threat to steal once on base - Cole has tremendous speed (now at 6.62). Defensively, he takes a quick first step and has plus lateral range. He creates angles around the GB with fluid actions. DP turns are quick with zip on his throws. Defensive abilities are superior as he shows big play potential. Cole has a ton of upside and possesses the skill-set that will play at a very high level."
